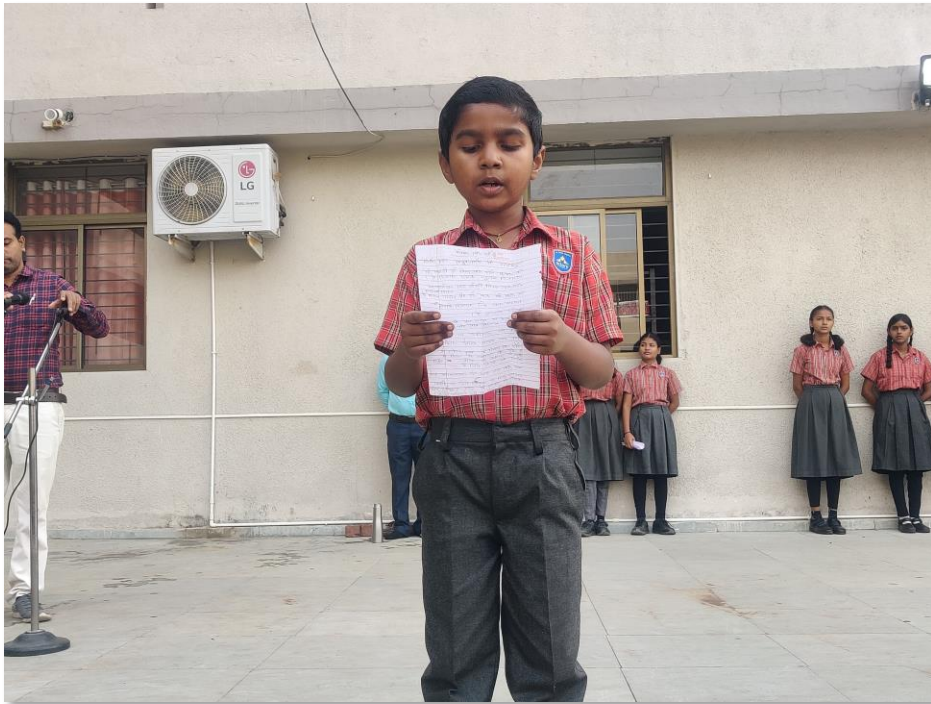
# SCHOOL REOPENING (01/04/2025)

Ram Navami was celebrated in our school on 04/04/2025 during the morning assembly with great enthusiasm and devotion. Student shared the significance of the festival.



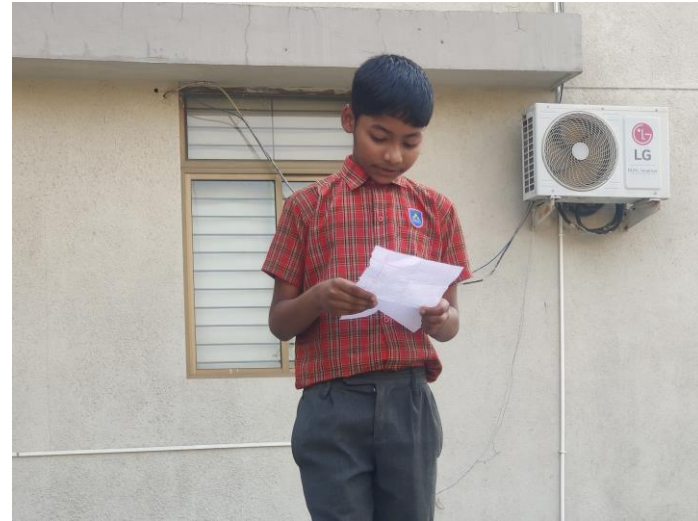
## FLOWER POT MAKING COMPETITION (09/04/2025)

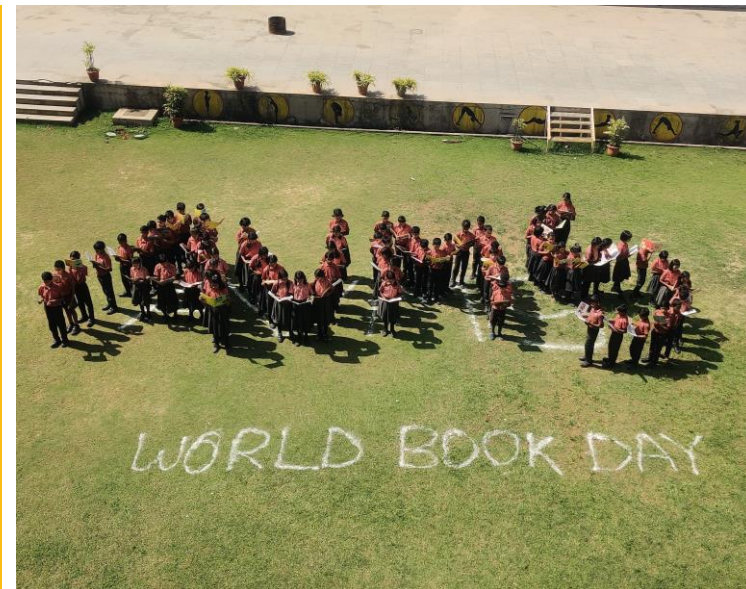


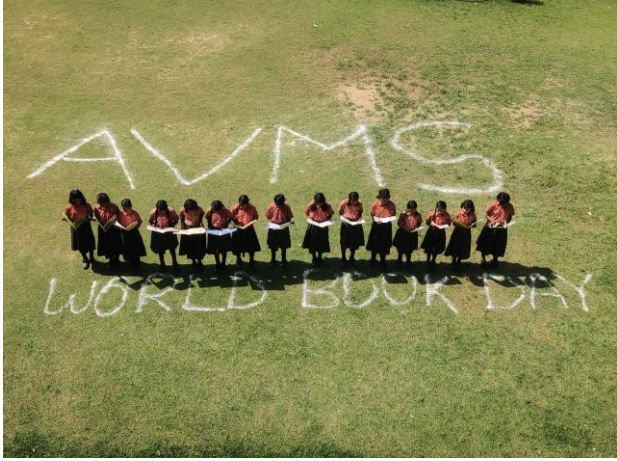
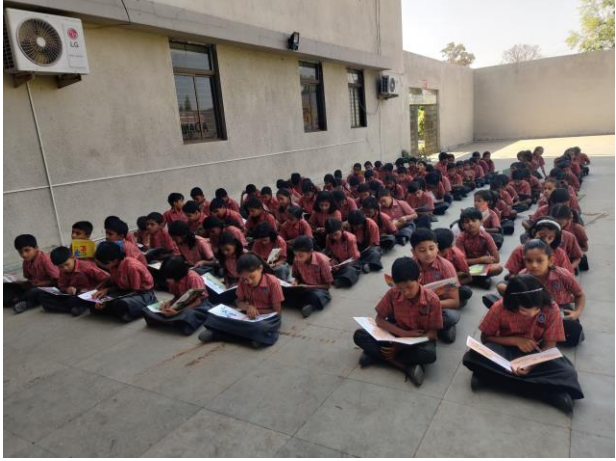
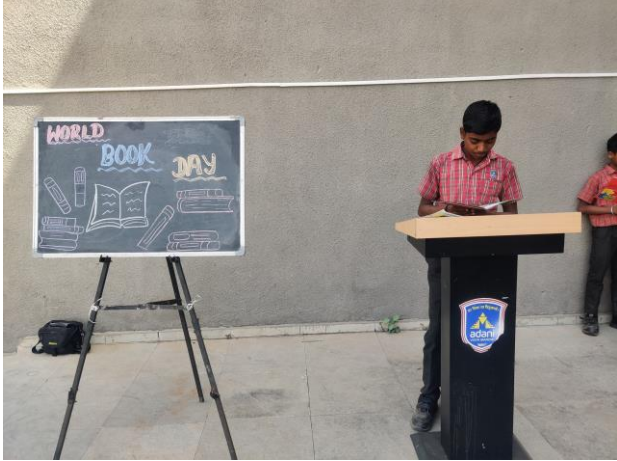
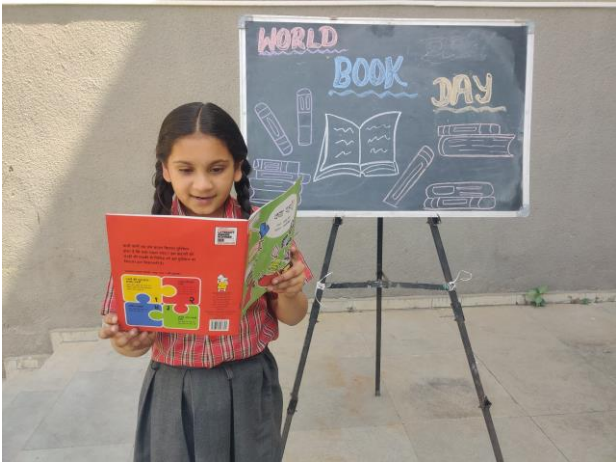




## World Book Day Celebration (23/04/2025)

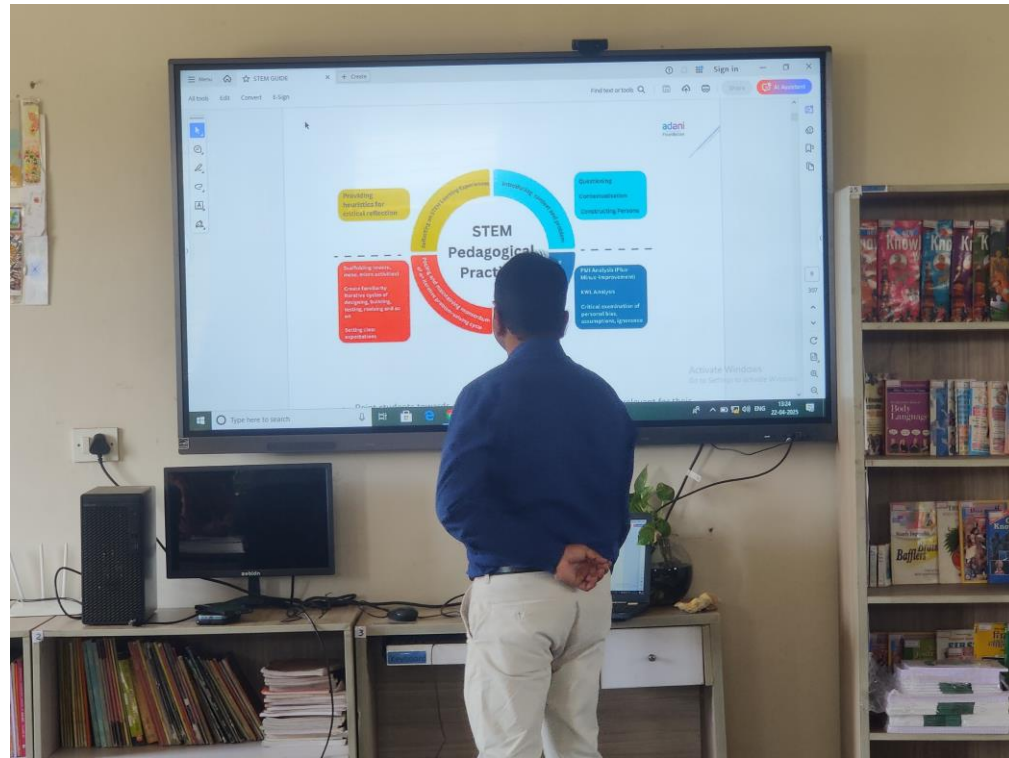
