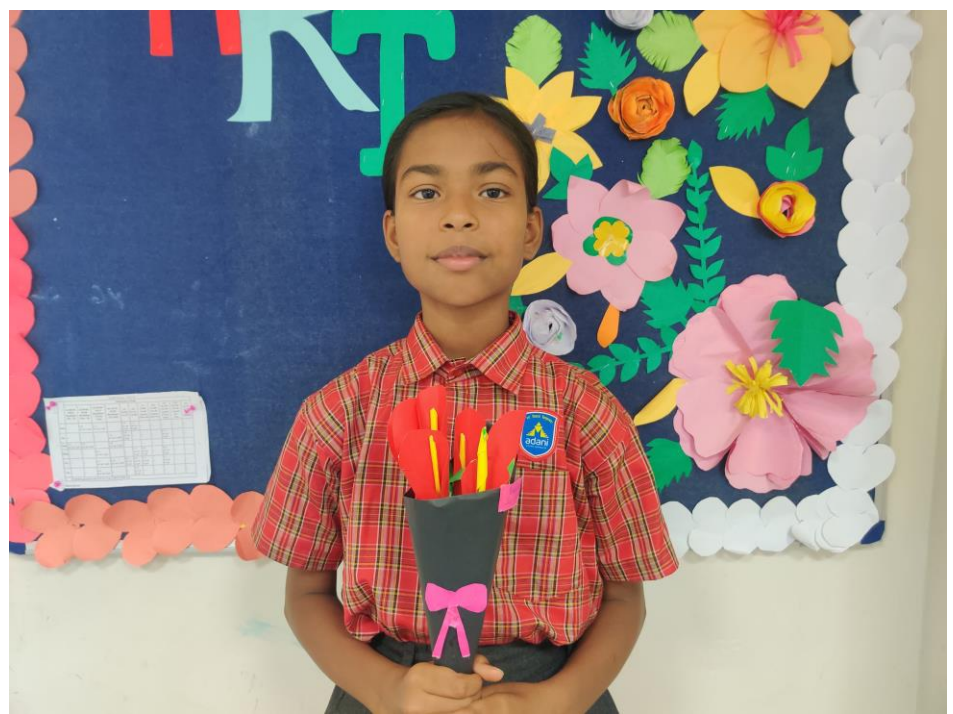


ARTIFICIAL FLOWER MAKING COMPETITION (20/06/2025)

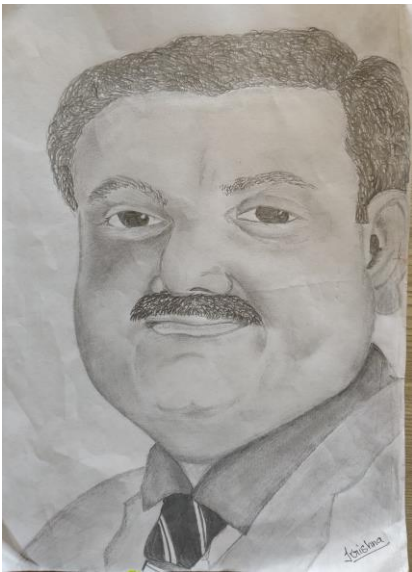

Birthday Celebration Hon'ble Chairman (24/06/2025)



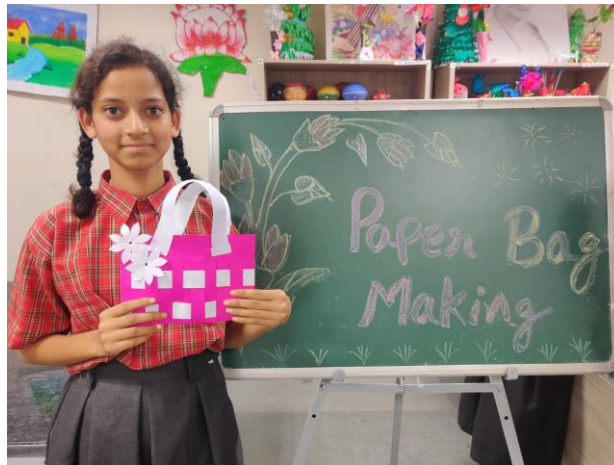
Rath Yatra (26/06/2025)
