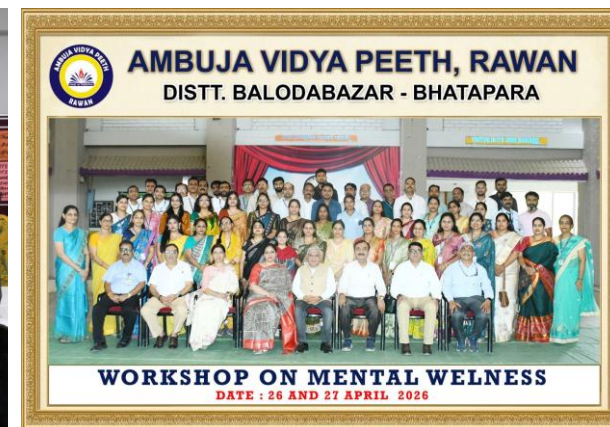
The programme began with the ceremonial lamp lighting symbolizing the removal of darkness and the spread of knowledge.
