Maths Activity - Factors and Multiples (10/08/2023)

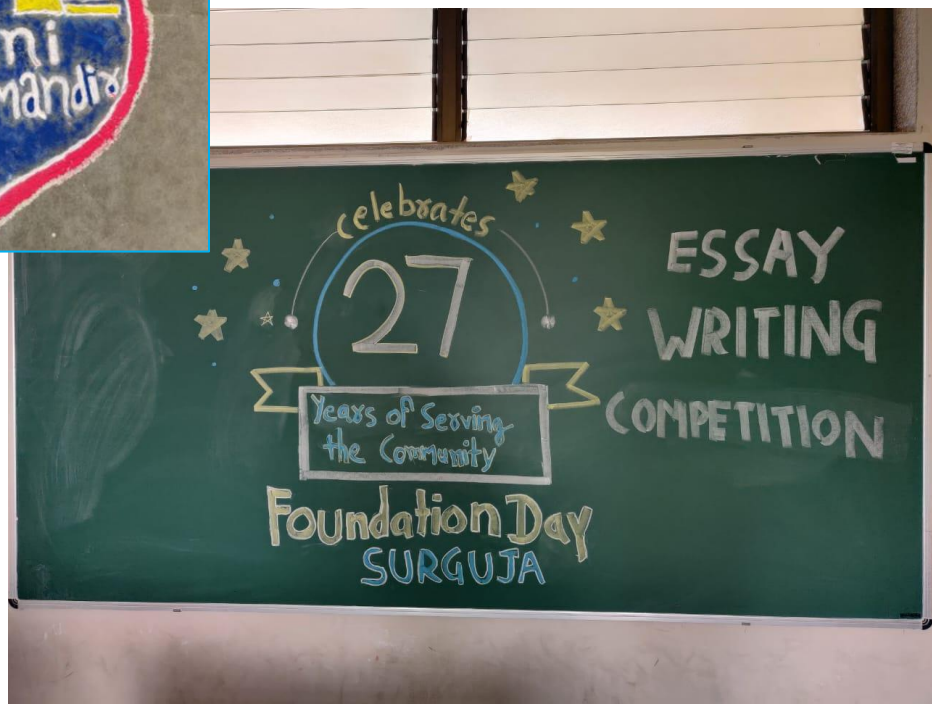

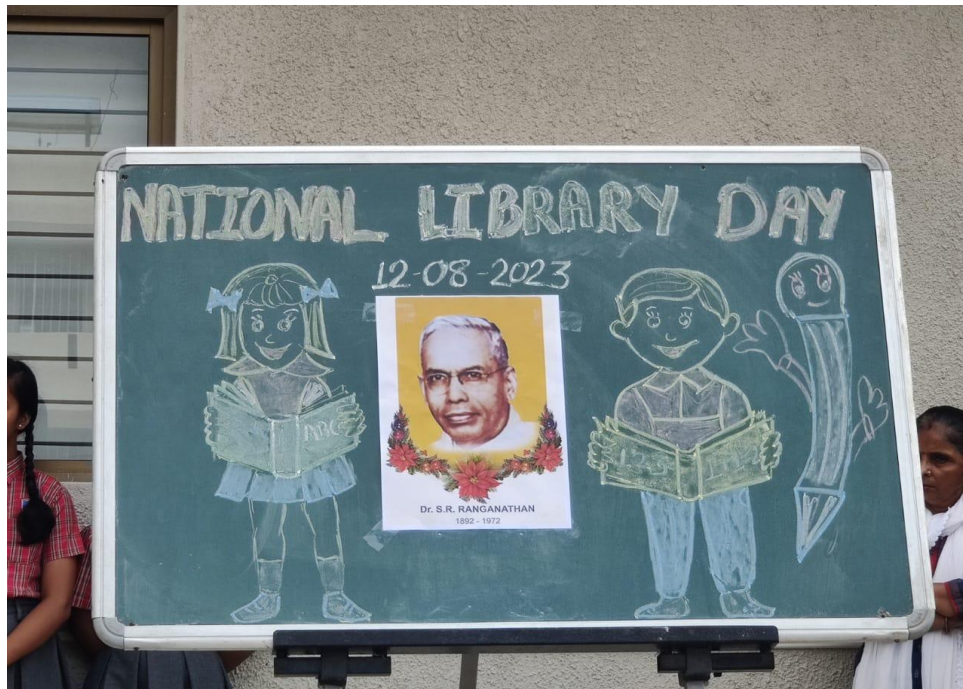




National Librarian's Day (12/08/2023)

August 12th, has been denoted National Librarian's Day in India. Dr. SR Ranganathan, who is known as the Father of Library Science in India, his birthday is observed every year as National Librarian Day in India. He was a university librarian and professor of Library Science at Banaras Hindu University from 1945 to 1947 and Professor of Library Science at the University of Delhi from 1947 to 1955.

Our school **AVMS** celebrated National Librarian's Day on 12th August, 2023 in which our librarian **Mrs. Farida Bano** threw light on the life of Dr. SR Ranganathan and the duties and contribution of librarians in our academies of present days.

Rakhi, Onam and National Sports Day Celebration (29/08/2023)

Raksha Bandhan is observed on the last day of the Hindu lunar calendar month of Shraavana, which typically falls in August. The expression "**Raksha Bandhan**" (Sanskrit, literally "the bond of protection, obligation, or care") is now principally applied to this ritual.

Onam is one of the major harvest festivals celebrated by the Malayali community with great pomp and enthusiasm across Kerala in India. It also marks the beginning of the Malayalam year, called Kolla Varsham.

Major Dhyan Chand (29 August 1905 – 3 December 1979) was an Indian field hockey player, regarded by many as the greatest field hockey player in history of the world. He was the captain of Indian Hockey Team. He won 3 gold medals in Olympic Games – 1928, 1932 and 1936. He hit more than 400 International goals in Hockey.

In our school AVMS students celebrated Raksha Bandhan, Onam and the birth anniversary of **Major Dhyanchand** with great zeal and enthusiasm. They performed activities like dance, skit, etc. Our respected sports teacher Mr. Vinod Kumar Singh and our honorable Principal Mr. Dilip Kumar touched the different aspects of the life of **Major Dhyanchand**.

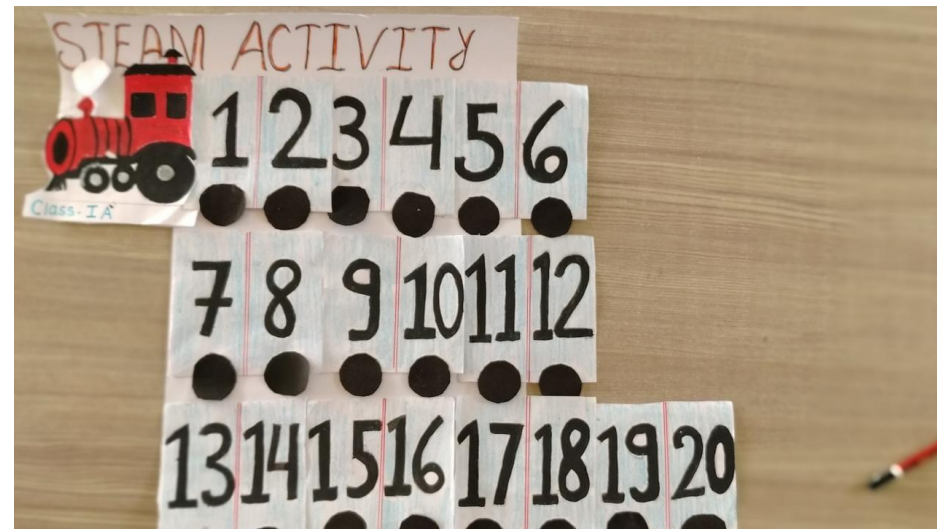
EVS Activity – Food We Eat (31/08/2023)
