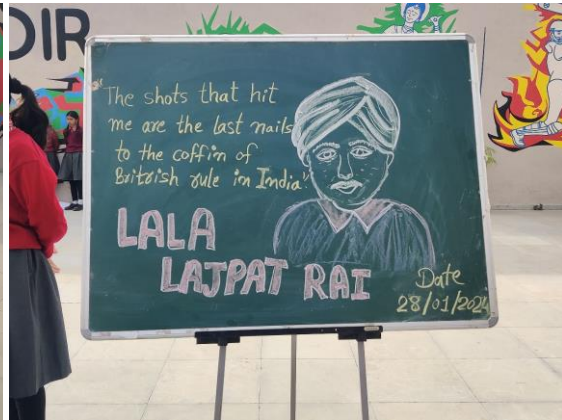




Lala Lajpat Rai Birth Anniversary (26/01/2024)
