


















































Chhattisgarh Foundation Day (04/11/2023)

1st November of every year is celebrated as **Chhattisgarh Rajyotsava** (Chhattisgarh Foundation Day) as on this date in the year 2000 Government of India officially declared it to be an independent state. The mythological name of Chhattisgarh is Kaushal Rajya. The mother of Lord **Shri Ram, Kaushalya** was the daughter of this kingdom. The President of India gave his consent to Madhya Pradesh Reorganisation Act 2000 on 25 August and then Government of India set 1 November 2000 as the day Madhya Pradesh would be divided into Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh.

Since then, the state government organizes a celebration of 5 days starting from 1st November every year in the capital of Chhattisgarh.

In our school students under the guidelines of the experienced teacher participated in the celebration enthusiastically and with great happiness.

Diwali Celebration (08/11/2023)

Diwali, or **Deepawali**, is <u>India</u>'s one of the biggest and most important festivals of Hindus. The festival gets its name from the row (avali) of clay lamps (deepa) that Indians light outside their homes to symbolize the inner light that protects from spiritual darkness. This festival commemorates the returning of lord Ram to Ayodhya after the exile of 14 years. People of Ayodhya cleaned their houses and paths and lighted lamp in rows to welcome shri Ram. Since then every year Deepawali is celebrated on the 15th day of Kartik month (A Hindi Month).

In our school students celebrated Deepawali by playing a skit based on the life of Shri Ram and they also sang holy songs related to Lord Ram and danced and also presented some examples of ideals from the life of God Ram.


Safety Week Program (30/11/2023)
