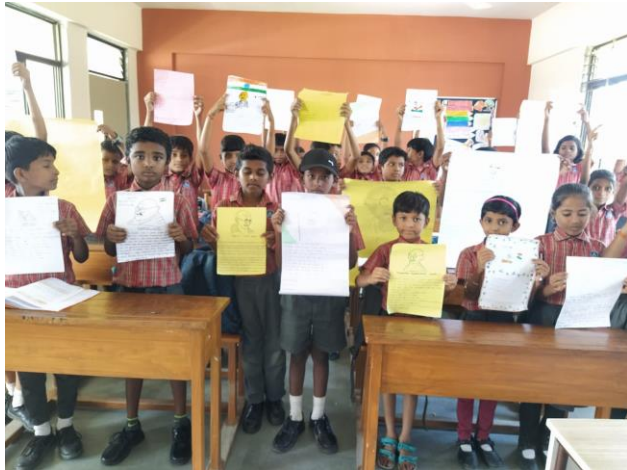




Gandhi Jayanti Drawing Competition (30/09/2023)
